3rd – 8th Grade Parents,

I'd like to take the opportunity to thank all of you who have taken the time to activate your Edline parent accounts. You will soon have access to weekly updates of your child's grades. I'd also like to encourage the few remaining parents who have not activated their Edline accounts to do so as soon as possible.

The first release of 2nd quarter grades for you to view on Edline will take place on Friday, October 28th. That evening, you will be able to see a snapshot of all of your child's grades in their major subjects. Please keep in mind that this is the first week of the second quarter and many teachers may not initially have any grades to post. Grades will always be updated to Edline on the last day of each school week for you to view.

Since you will now have a weekly breakdown of your child's grades, progress reports will no longer be issued at the half way point in each quarter. Additionally, procedure notices will no longer be issued to students for not having homework or for not getting a test signed. Procedure notices will still be issued for not coming to class prepared with necessary supplies. You will now be able to see if a homework grade has dropped or if a low test or quiz grade has been posted to Edline. Please visit the site weekly and keep a close eye on your child's progress.
