In the past I called the Admission Directors of the Catholic High Schools to ask about letters of recommendation. Most of the high schools told me that they do NOT require letters of recommendation for admission. They gather most of their information through interviews and/or by visiting with Mrs. Levet.

If your child is applying for a scholarship, check with the individual high school for the proper procedure to follow and their scholarship criteria. Letters of recommendation **may** be required for the scholarship process.
